LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18)

- The areas around the 1st & 18th fairways as defined by white posts.
- Beyond the fence (boundary of the course) running from the 2nd tee to the back of the 7th tee.
- Area to the right of the 7th hole as defined by white posts.
- On or over the wall adjacent to the 18th green.

2. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

- All artificial structures, the electricity poles adjacent to the 18th green, pailings, posts, made up paths and their wooden surrounds, manhole covers, sheds, wooden steps, the outflow pipe and supports between holes 7 & 8, the windmill and all concrete structures.
- The netting in place over the ditch that runs from holes 12, 14 and 15.
- The entrance road and track leading

from it from the 1st to the back of the 8th green.

- If a sprinkler head lies within 2 club lengths of the putting green of hole in play, and intervenes on line of play between ball and hole, and ball lies within 2 club lengths of obstruction, relief may be taken.
- The steps and timber supports in bunkers.

NOTES

- The estuary flood bank between the 14th and 18th tees is an integral part of the course, with no relief except under penalty.
 - The fence defining the boundary of the course between the 2nd and 7th tees does not afford relief; relief must be taken under penalty.
- ### 3. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS (Rule 16)
- All drainage ditches NOT marked by red or yellow stakes.
 - Tractor tyre marks.
 - Temporary greens when defined.

d. A white stake within a bunker declares the bunker as not in play. Relief may be taken without penalty.

4. RED PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

- All ponds and ditches, as defined by red lines or stakes.
- All beaches on the estuary side of the course.

5. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 17)

All ponds and ditches, as defined by yellow lines or stakes.

6. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 15 applies).

7. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

For general play and competition, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only (Rule 4).

8. The 150 yd markers are to the centre of the green

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
